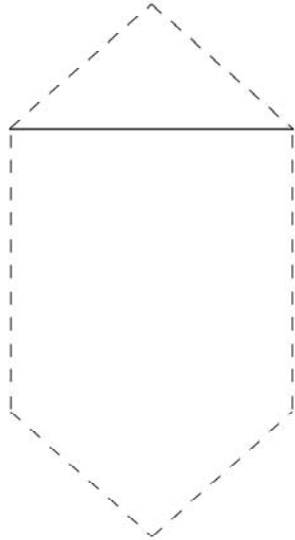
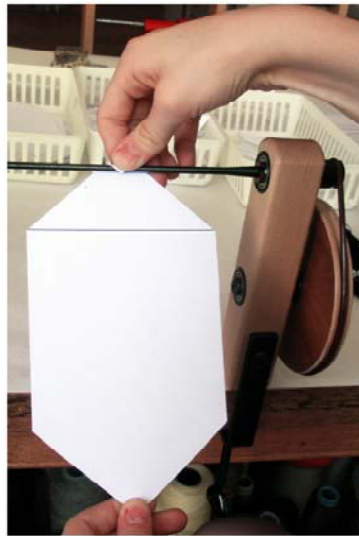


HOW TO: ROLLING PAPER PATTERN INTO A QUILL

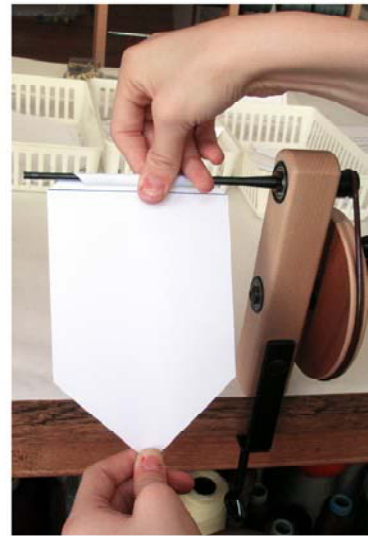
The paper quill we are using is a kind of bobbin.

2 (Louet hand bobbin winder)

- 1 Diagram of paper quill pattern. (master to-scale pattern available)
- 2 Position paper quill pattern with the tip behind the rod on the bobbin winder, horizontal line towards the top, left paper edge just to the inside of end of rod. Curl the top point over the rod and begin winding. Hold the bottom point with one hand for tension. With your other hand in the center of the pattern, roll the paper up tightly around the rod. Some individuals prefer using both hands in the middle to wind.
- 3 Make sure the horizontal line is parallel to the rod -- helps to make sure your winding is straight on the rod.

Continue winding, watching that the edges wind evenly. Keep the roll tight.

- 4 When you wind all the way to the bottom point, place a small dab of quick drying glue to the paper tip. Using one of the paper triangles in a container on your worktable, press that tip flat onto the paper quill. Remove any excess glue using the paper triangle. Toss triangle. Place quill into storage container!
